MOTION OF KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY FOR LEAVE TO DEVIATE FROM FILING REQUIREMENTS

Kentucky Power Company ("Kentucky Power") moves the Commission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22, for leave to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(3) and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(12)(b).
