**LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY AND  
KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY'S  
JOINT PETITION FOR DEVIATION FROM FILING REQUIREMENTS**

Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) and Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) (collectively, the “Companies”) petition the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22 to grant permission to file responses to certain Items of the First Data Request of Sterling Ventures, LLC (“SV 1-”) and Commission Staff’s Initial Requests for Information (“PSC 1-”) on a compact disc and thumb drive rather than uploading and filing paper due to the large volume of the responses. In support of this Joint Petition, the Companies state as follows:

1. The Companies’ responses to the following items are voluminous and would be impractical and/or impossible to upload to the Commission’s electronic filing system<sup>1</sup> and costly to produce in paper form: PSC 1-6(a); SV 1-2(e); and SV 1-14. The response to PSC 1-6(a) totals approximately 8 gigabytes of information. The response to SV 1-2(e) totals 270 megabytes of information. The response to SV 1-14 totals approximately 56 gigabytes of information. The Companies propose to submit the response to PSC 1-6(a) on a compact disc.

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<sup>1</sup> 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(6) limits an uploading session to 100 megabytes and an individual file to 30 megabytes.


The Companies propose to submit the responses to SV 1-2(e) and SV 1-14 on a thumb drive. Duplicate compact discs and thumb drives will be delivered to the intervenors in this matter.

2. Therefore, the Companies request permission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22, to deviate from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(3) by submitting to the Commission and serving on parties of record this information on a compact disc and thumb drive.

**WHEREFORE**, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company respectfully request approval to deviate from the standard filing requirements and submit the above-described information on a compact disc or other mass-storage device.
