**AT&T KENTUCKY’S ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-DAY STATUS REPORT**

AT&T Kentucky<sup>1</sup> files one hundred twenty-day status report in compliance with the Order the Commission entered in this case on August 17, 2016.

AT&T Kentucky has been operating under the agreed-upon 911 arrangements with Laurel County Communications Center, Bluegrass 911, and Knox County for more than three months, and from AT&T Kentucky’s perspective, the transition is proceeding smoothly and without issue. AT&T Kentucky remains willing to work with other PSAP members of the Central Kentucky Network to transition to substantially similar 911 arrangements upon request.

In light of the foregoing, AT&T Kentucky submits that it would be appropriate to dismiss this proceeding without prejudice and will work with the other parties to determine their willingness to submit a joint or unopposed motion to that effect.
