Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company LLC submits this electronic filing in order to correct the information contained in the "Intra-Agency Memorandum" dated November 25, 2015.

On November 13, 2015, CBT participated in an informal conference in Case 2015-00227, Application of Bellsouth Telecommunications, LLC for Declaratory Order Regarding Interconnection with Central Kentucky Network for 911/E911 Services to Public Safety Answering Points. At this conference, CBT made the following statements that are not reflected in the record:

- CBT stated that it has not delivered live e911 traffic historically nor is it currently delivering live e911 traffic to Central Kentucky Network. CBT did indicate that it did a proof of concept test with its vendor microDATA and Central Kentucky Network but that it was in a test environment and not on its network.
- CBT has an interconnection agreement with Intrado Communications, an e911 provider in both Ohio and Kentucky that governs the handoff of e911 traffic.

In accordance with 807 KAR 5:001 Section 8, the electronically filed documents are a true representation of the original documents to be filed with the Commission.
