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(e) Other Matters — Wrapping up the administration of the program, the change order for Contract No. 028369110001X110 increases expenditures for the Company's commercial Express Install program by \$218,825.69 from \$213,600 to \$432,425.69. The increase covers expenditures in connection with customer applications received for the Express Install program prior to Kentucky Power suspending the program in connection with the Commission's declaratory order. The last Express Install audit was performed on May 11, 2017, and the last customer commitment to the program in connection with an earlier performed audit was May 22, 2017. (Customers have 45 days from the date of the audit to commit to the program.)

The change order for Contract No. 027530170026X110 provides for a net \$22,898 reduction in contract amounts for the Whole Efficiency Program. Although the change order reduces overall spending for the Whole House Efficiency Program, the change order reflects increases in certain program measures. These increases are offset by larger decreases in other measures under the program to produce the \$22,298 reduction in the contract amount.
