ATTORNEY GENERAL'S STATEMENT



The Attorney General requests that the Commission consider in its adjudication a process in which the companies may provide reports or informal updates regarding the status, success, and progress of the project. The Attorney General looks forward to following the development of this plan, especially as to what affect it has on rate-payers, if any, going forward and hopes the Commission takes an ongoing interest in its advancement as well.
