RE: Application of Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company to Install and Operate Electric Charging Stations in Their Certified Territories, for Approval of an Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment Rider, an Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment Rate, an Electric Vehicle Charging Rate, Depreciation Rate, and for a Deviation from the Requirements of Certain Commission Regulations Case No. 2015-00355

Dear Dr. Mathews:

The Kentucky Public Service Commission issued an Order on April 11, 2016 in the above-referenced proceeding granting approval of Louisville Gas and Electric Company's and Kentucky Utilities Company's proposed tariffs of Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment ("EVSE"), Electric Vehicle Charging ("EVC"), and Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment Rider ("EVSE-R"). The Companies stated in this proceeding their plans of updating these tariffs annually. The annual updates would reflect annual mechanism averages for the EVC rates as well as the adjustment of the annual usage assumptions based on actual station usage.

The Companies recently filed applications in Case Nos. 2016-00370 and 2016-00371 that requested adjustments to the tariffs. The request included updates to the EVSE, EVC, and EVSE-R rates. The Companies request the 2017 update to the EVSE, EVC, and EVSE-R rates be updated in accordance with the final order

in Case Nos. 2016-00370 and 2016-00371. Annual updates to the EVSE, EVC, and EVSE-R rates will continue once these proceedings are closed.
