### Lawmakers: Budget deal is deadlocked

PRANKPORT (AP) - Kentucky lawmakers say they have reached an impasse on budget negotiations, put-ting a two-year spending plan in jeop-ardy and risking a partial government

shutdown.
House and Senate leaders
annunced at about 10:30 Thursday
morning they were unable to reach
a deal. They have met secretly for
several days trying to reach a compromise in time for the legislature to
approve the deal an Priday.
House Democrats insist they will
not allow burder cuts for efforts for

not allow budget cuts for education.

Senate Republicans says the cuts are needed to pay down the state's mnre than \$30 billion pension dobt. Lawmakers could still pass a budget by April 15. But Democratic House Speaker Greg Stumbo said the only way he would agree to that is if Republican Gov. Matt Bevin agreed he would not veto parts of the budget.
