Of course I would support their decision no matter what it is, but do I have a responsibility to tell her I don't think they should be together?

No, because that's a conclusion you've drawn for her from what you've witnessed, and she could draw a completely different one from what she has experienced.


But if you stick to telling her what you've witnessed, letting her draw the conclusions, then you'd have solid standing to speak up this time.
