Enclosed please find and accept for filing Louisville Gas and Electric Company's ("LG&E") request for a change in the timing for filing the status update reports and the proposed ES Forms to conform to the Commission's final Order dated August 8, 2016 submitted in electronic medium in the above-referenced matter.

Ordering Paragraph 9 requires LG&E to submit status reports on its 2016 ECR Plan every three months from the date of the final Order issued on August 8, 2016. In Ordering Paragraph 11, the Executive Director is delegated the authority to grant a reasonable extension of time for filing said status report. LG&E respectfully requests to submit the status reports no later than 30 days following the end of each calendar quarter with the first report filed no later than October 31, 2016.


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In addition, LG&E proposes to modify the ES Forms to conform to Ordering Paragraph 5 that establishes the ROE for the 2016 ECR Plan. Attached are the proposed ES Forms 1.00, 1.10, and 2.00 modified to separately show the calculations for the 2009 and 2011 ECR Plan and the 2016 ECR Plan with the authorized ROE for each. Pursuant to the terms of the Settlement Agreement and the final Order, LG&E will implement the proposed ES Form changes with the July 2016 expense month filing to be submitted on August 19, 2016.
