MOTION TO WITHDRAW

Metro FiberNet, LLC (“MetroNet”) moves to withdraw from participation in the above-referenced case. In its Order¹ initiating this case, the Commission made each local exchange carrier, commercial mobile radio service provider, and eligible telecommunications carrier (“ETC”) a party to this proceeding. Order, p. 1. The Commission also gave any party that is not an ETC in Kentucky receiving both federal universal service fund (“USF”) and state support the opportunity to file a written request setting forth the reasons why withdrawal as a party is appropriate. Order, p. 6. MetroNet moves to withdraw and provides the reasons therefore based upon the attached statement of request to withdraw.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons stated in the attached statement of request to withdraw, MetroNet respectfully requests that it be permitted to withdraw from further participation in this proceeding.
