**JOINT MOTION OF ATTORNEY GENERAL AND DUKE ENERGY  
KENTUCKY, INC. TO RESCHEDULE HEARING DATE AND REQUEST FOR  
EXPEDITED TREATMENT**

Come now the parties, Duke Energy of Kentucky, Inc. (“DEK”) and the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky by and through his Office of Rate Intervention, both by counsel, and hereby jointly move that the Commission reschedule the hearing date in this matter. In support of this motion, the parties state as follows.

The hearing date in this matter is currently scheduled for December 1, 2016. In the past two weeks, the parties have been discussing the issues in this matter in order to determine whether a settlement may be possible. The parties believe that good progress has been made. However, the parties note that in light of the upcoming Thanksgiving Holiday, they may need additional time in order to determine whether settlement may be possible. DEK notes that on Tuesday, November 15, 2016 it reached a settlement in principle with the Commission Staff in Case No. 2016-00349 for which a hearing had been scheduled on the Commission’s docket

for December 8, 2016. Since that hearing is no longer needed, the parties recommend that the Commission reschedule the hearing in this matter to December 8, 2016.

The parties request that the Commission issue an order granting the request to reschedule the hearing in this matter to December 8, 2016 as soon as practical, so that DEK has sufficient time to provide public notice of the change in hearing date to December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2016.

WHEREFORE, the parties respectfully request that the Commission grant their motion.

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
