

Corrected Official Notice

Licking Valley Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation, with its principal office at 271 Main Street, P.O. Box 605, West Liberty, KY 41472, intends to file with the Kentucky Public Service Commission in Case No. 2016-00174 an application to adjust its retail rates and charges. This adjustment will result in a general rate increase to the member-consumers of Licking Valley Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation and was filed on August 8, 2016. Licking Valley will find the revised information with the Kentucky Public Service Commission on August ____, 2016 with an effective date of September ____, 2016.

However, the Kentucky Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates in this application.

A person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, Post Office Box 615, Frankfort, KY 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. If the Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of initial publication or mailing of the notice, the Commission may take final action on the application.
