The Kentucky Public Service Commission's ("Commission") November 4, 2016 Order required Kentucky Utilities Company and Louisville Gas and Electric Company (collectively, the "Companies") to file annual reports for three years updating the Commission on the number of Solar Share Facilities constructed, current participation levels and other relevant information.

In accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, I certify that the electronically filed documents are a true and accurate copy of the same documents being filed in paper medium; that the electronic filing has been transmitted to the Commission on November 4, 2019; that there are currently no parties in this proceeding that the Commission has excused from participation by electronic means; and that the original and six copies of this filing in paper medium will be filed with the Commission within two business days from the date of the electronic filing.

On July 26, 2019, the first Facility became fully operational. As of October 31, 2019, subscription information for the first Facility is as follows:
