JOINT MOTION

ADJUSTMENT OF ITS ELECTRIC AND GAS

PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

RATES AND FOR CERTIFICATES OF

Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") and Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") (collectively "Companies") hereby respectfully move for leave to file the written Stipulation and Recommendation ("Stipulation") entered into by nearly all of the parties to these proceedings, namely the Companies; Association of Community Ministries, Inc.; Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through the Office of Rate Intervention; Community Action Council for Lexington-Fayette, Bourbon, Harrison and Nicholas Counties, Inc.; United States Department of Defense and All Other Federal Executive Agencies; Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc.; Kentucky League of Cities; The Kroger Company; Kentucky School Boards Association; Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government; Louisville/Jefferson County Metro Government; Metropolitan Housing Coalition; Sierra Club, Alice Howell, Carl Vogel and Amy Waters; JBS Swift & Co.; and Wal-Mart Stores East, LP and Sam's East, Inc. (collectively "Stipulating Parties").

As grounds for their motion, the Companies state that the Stipulating Parties and Commission Staff attended an informal conference at the Commission's offices on April 12, 13, and 17, 2017, at the offices of the Commission, which representatives of BellSouth Telecommunications, LLC d/b/a AT&T Kentucky ("AT&T") and Kentucky Cable Telecommunications Association ("KCTA") also attended on April 12 and 13, and which representatives of KCTA also attended on April 17, to discuss settlement of the issues in these cases. The Stipulating Parties have reached a settlement of all the issues and have documented their understanding in the Stipulation; to date, AT&T and KCTA have not entered into the Stipulation.

The Companies intend to file an additional Joint Motion by Monday, April 24, 2017, seeking leave to file testimony in support of the Stipulation.

Also, as the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government has noted on its signature page, its joining in the Stipulation is subject to ratification by the Urban County Council; ratification is expected when the council next meets on April 27, 2017.

WHEREFORE, KU and LG&E request the Commission enter an order granting the Companies leave to file the Stipulation.
