Dear Mr. Cogan:

This letter is to inform you of the method upon which the Bullitt County Sanitation District shall proceed in assisting Bullitt Utilities in the matter of the failure of the Hunters Hollow Wastewater Treatment Facility.

The District's Attorney has recommended to the Commissioners the terms upon which to proceed and our Commissioners have formally adopted the recommendations as set forth below:

> The attached invoices: for work efforts to date to resolve the problem in the amount of \$14,603.90 must be paid immediately.

The District will, based on your and/or your on-site representatives' concurrence of scope of work, continue to assist providing the estimated cost of the scope of work is paid in advance.

The immediate problem is the diversion of as much flow as possible from the Hunters Hollow WWTP to the Districts other plants by way of the temporary force main and our Union Tool Pump Station. This work is in place and the District is finalizing the set-up of the Union Tool Pump Station. The cost of the wholesale treatment of wastewater from the Hunters Hollow WWTP shall be \$4.62 per 1,000 gallons. The District shall determine the flow rate from your existing pump and install an hour meter on the control panel for billing purposes.

A short term solution to divert dry weather flow from Hunters Hollow should be engineered next. The District believes all wastewater flow from Hunters Hollow, except for extreme peak flow, can be diverted to either our Pioneer Village WWTP or our Prologis WWTP. This would allow Bullitt Utilities to decommission the temporary treatment facility while all parties are developing a long term solution.

> The long term solution would be the construction of a new facility at either our Pioneer Village WWTP or our Prologis WWTP.

The estimated costs for the short term and long term solutions must be paid in advance to an interest bearing escrow account from which the District may withdraw funds to pay for engineering, land acquisition and construction. An additional deposit may be required depending on the opening of the bids.

The Commissioners of the Bullitt County Sanitation District have adopted the above recommendations in order to protect the current customers of the District should Bullitt Utilities and/or the Kentucky Division of Water have a change of direction in solving the problem.

Please advise the District if the above terms and conditions are acceptable in order that a new scope of work can be completed.
