The City of Madisonville was directed to produce the information and documentation on or before June 23, 2017. Counsel for the City has met with Charles A. Kington, Certified Public Accountant who made the calculations for the proposed rate increase and who prepared the annual audits for the City of Madisonville, the City Engineer, and representatives of the City of Madisonville Finance Department in an effort to produce the information requested. However, Cory C. Alexander, Finance Director for the City of Madisonville, broke his foot two (2) days ago and was not able to participate in the meeting. Mr. Alexander's involvement is essential to provide the information requested by the Commission. The undersigned attorney has spoken with Honorable Damon R. Talley, attorney for the Nebo Water District and the North Hopkins Water District, and Mr. Talley advised that he had no objection to the City of Madisonville's request for additional time to respond to the Commission Staff's Request for Information.

The City of Madisonville further requests clarification concerning how the

information is to be produced. The Commission Staff's Request directed the City to file

with the Commission the original with six (6) copies in paper medium and an electronic

version of the information. The audit reports for 2014, 2015 and 2016 requested in

paragraph 1 are each approximately 120 pages. The general ledger for Madisonville's

water operations as referenced in paragraph 2 will be approximately 350 to 400 pages.

All of these documents can be furnished to the Commission in an electronic version and

the City of Madisonville certainly will produce six (6) copies in paper medium, if so directed

by the Commission.

There are no materials not included in the electronic filing, and the electronically

filed documents are a true representation of the original documents to be filed with the

Commission.
