

Please Note!

The 2017 County tax bills are due and payable at the Estill County Sheriff's office as of October 1, 2017. The following are collection dates:

2% Discount October 1, 2017- November 1, 2017

Face amount November 2, 2017- December 31, 2017

5% penalty January 1, 2018- January 31, 2018

21% penalty February 1, 2018- April 16, 2018 (close of business)

The Estill County Sheriff's office will transfer the delinquent property tax bills to the county clerk as of the close of business on April 16th.

IMPORTANT:

•Anyone who has not received his or her tax bill should contact the Estill County Sheriff's Office.

•Anyone whose taxes are paid through an escrow account is responsible for forwarding the tax bills to their mortgage company.

•When paying by mail, please include your copy of the tax bill or put the bill number on your check. The tax bill number is needed to provide you efficient service. If you wish a paid receipt returned to you, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope with your remittance
