
**Documents For Which Leave Is Sought To File Original  
and Six Copies on Compact Disc**

Kentucky Power seeks leave to file on compact disc in lieu of the required paper original and six paper copies of its third Supplemental Attachment 1 to the Company's response to Attorney General's supplemental request 1-42 electronically filed on December 1, 2017. That attachment, labeled KPCO\_SR\_AG\_1\_042\_3rd\_Supplemental\_Attachment1.pdf, comprises the Company's October 2017 General Ledger. The original of the this information totals over 2,500 pages. An original and six paper copies of this information would measure over eight feet in height. Providing the original and six paper copies in electronic format is more efficient and should not impede review of the Company's application.

Wherefore Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order:

1. Granting the Company's motion for leave to deviate from the Commission's April 27, 2017 order in this case by filing the required paper original and six paper copies of KPCO\_SR\_AG\_1\_042\_3rd\_Supplemental\_Attachment1.pdf on compact disc in lieu of paper format;
2. Granting such further relief to which the Company may be entitled.
