Paragraph 14(c) of the Settlement Agreement in Case No. 2014-00396¹ provides:

Kentucky Power agrees beginning on or before March 31, 2016, and each March 31st thereafter, it shall make an informational filing with the Commission quantifying and describing the amounts deferred in accordance with this paragraph 14. A copy of this annual informational filing shall be served by Kentucky Power upon counsel for all parties to this proceeding.

Due to constraints on Kentucky Power Company's employees attributable to the novel coronavirus COVID-19 pandemic, Kentucky Power has identified the need for additional time to prepare and submit its 2019 NERC Compliance and Cybersecurity Deferral Report. Kentucky Power estimates that it can provide the report and supporting calculations by May 1, 2020.

The motion is not made for an improper purpose. The Company believes that granting the motion will not adversely affect its customers, the Commission or its staff, or the parties to this proceeding.
