Kentucky Power Company’s Supplemental Notice Of Anticipated Filing Date For Its 2019
FRR/RPM Election Analysis

The Commission’s January 18, 2018 order in Case No. 2017-00179 directed Kentucky Power Company to file its annual FRR/RPM election analysis in connection with PJM Interconnection, L.L.C.’s annual Base Residual Auction “after the information becomes public.”¹ Typically the information becomes public and is filed by Kentucky Power in April of each year.

By order dated August 30, 2018 the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission granted PJM Interconnection LLC’s motion to extend PJM’s 2019 Base Residual Auction for the 2022/2023 delivery year until August 14-28, 2019.² FERC subsequently entered an order on July 25, 2019 denying PJM’s motion for supplemental clarification and directing PJM not to

conduct the 2019 Base Residual Auction in August 2019.³ It is now uncertain when the 2019 Base Residual Auction will be conducted.

Once the 2019 Base Residual Auction is scheduled, the information reflected in the Company's analysis will be publicly disclosed approximately 60 days prior to the scheduled date of the auction. Kentucky Power will file the required analysis promptly thereafter.
