Motion For Leave To Deviate

Kentucky Power Company moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22 for leave to deviate with respect to certain voluminous documents from the requirement in the Commission's April 27, 2017 order that it file with the Commission an original and six copies in paper medium of all documents filed electronically in this case.

Kentucky Power seeks leave to file the following attachments on compact disc in lieu of the required paper original and six paper copies:

- KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment1.pdf (3,089 pages)
- KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment2.pdf (3,048 pages)
- KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment4.pdf (1,629 pages)

KPCO_R_AG_1_20_Attachment1_Redacted.pdf comprises the vegetation management contracts that support the Company's response to Request 20 of the Attorney General's First Set of Data Requests.

KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment1.pdf, KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment2.pdf, and KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment4.pdf comprise a portion of the general ledger documents that support the Company's response to Request 42 of the Attorney General's First Set of Data Requests. A single copy of these four attachments total over 9,000 pages. An original and six copies of each attachment provided in paper medium would measure nearly 30 feet in height. Providing the original and six copies in electronic format is more efficient and should not impede review of the Company's application.

Kentucky Power seeks leave to file the required six copies of the following attachments on compact disc in lieu of the required six paper copies. The Company proposes to file the original of the following attachments on paper and the required six copies on compact disc:

- KPCO_R_AG_1_44_Attachment1.pdf (623 pages)

KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment3.pdf comprises a portion of the general ledger documents that support the Company's response to Request 42 of the Attorney General's First Set of Data Requests. KPCO_R_AG_1_44_Attachment1.pdf comprises the Company's accounting manuals that support the Company's response to Request 44 of the Attorney General's First Set of Data Requests. These two attachments total 1,303 pages in length. Six copies provided in paper medium would measure more than 42 inches in height. Providing the original on paper and six copies in electronic format is more efficient and should not impede review of the Company's application.

Wherefore Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order:

1. Granting the Company's motion for leave to deviate from the Commission's April 27, 2017 order in this case by filing the required original and six copies of KPCO_R_AG_1_20_Attachment1_Redacted.pdf, KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment1.pdf, KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment2.pdf, and KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment4.pdf on compact disc in lieu of paper format;

2. Granting the Company's motion for leave to deviate from the Commission's April 27, 2017 order in this case by filing the required originals of KPCO_R_AG_1_42_Attachment3.pdf and KPCO_R_AG_1_44_Attachment1.pdf on paper, and the required six copies on compact disc in lieu of paper format;

3. Granting such further relief to which the Company may be entitled.
