Motion For Leave To Deviate

Kentucky Power Company moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22 for leave to deviate with respect to certain voluminous documents from the requirement in the Commission's April 27, 2017 order that it file with the Commission an original and six copies in paper medium of all documents filed electronically in this case.

**Documents For Which Leave Is Sought To File Original
On Compact Disc**

Kentucky Power seeks leave to file on compact disc in lieu of the required paper original of the confidential version of Attachment 1 to the Company's response to Attorney General's request 2-14. KPCO_R_AG_2_14_Attachment1_Confidential.pdf comprises information furnished to PJM concerning the Hazard-Wooton transmission line. The original of the confidential version of this information total over 18,000 pages and would measure over eight feet in height. Providing the original in electronic format is more efficient and should not impede review of the Company's application. Because the attachment is confidential in its entirety, the redacted version will be provided in paper medium in accordance with the Commission's April 27, 2017 Order.

Wherefore Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order:

1. Granting the Company's motion for leave to deviate from the Commission's April 27, 2017 order in this case by filing the required original of KPCO_R_AG_2_14_Attachment1_Confidential.pdf on compact disc in lieu of paper format;
2. Granting such further relief to which the Company may be entitled.
