**Kentucky Power Company's
Notice Of Filing In Response To Commission's July 20, 2018 Order**

On September 20, 2017 Kentucky Power Company filed a motion seeking in part confidential treatment for those portions of the Company's responses to AG 2-71 and AG 2-101 that provided compensation information for executives that, under federal law, is treated as confidential until the information is included in public filings with the federal Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC"). Executive compensation information filed with the SEC became public in March 2018. The remaining previously confidential information remains non-public.

The Commission on July 20, 2018 denied as moot that portion of the Company's September 20, 2017 responses to AG 2-071 and AG 2-101 that provided compensation information for executives that became public in March 2018. The Commission granted the Company's motion in all other respects.

The Commission's July 20, 2018 order directed the Company to file revised responses to AG 2-071 and AG 2-101 reflecting as unredacted the information for which confidential treatment was denied as moot.


In conformity with the Commission's July 20, 2018 order Kentucky Power is filing with this notice the following revised portions of its response:

The remaining confidential portions of the Company's responses to AG 2-071 and AG 2-101 remain confidential and were not made public in the March 2018 filings with the SEC.

Kentucky Power also is filing under seal with the Commission its revised confidential responses to attachments 1 and 3 to the Company's response to AG 2-071.
