CUSTOMER NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the Dexter-Almo Heights Water District expects to file an application on or about April 27, 2017 with the Kentucky Public Service Commission seeking approval of a proposed adjustment to its water rates. The proposed rates shall not become effective until the Public Service Commission has issued an order approving these rates or six (6) months from the filing of the application, whichever occurs first.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed rates, then the monthly bill for a residential customer using an average of 4,000 gallons per month will increase from \$23.77 to \$26.14. This is an increase of \$2.37 or 10.00%. The monthly bill for a commercial customer using an average of 3,000 gallons per month will increase from \$18.64 to \$20.50. This is an increase of \$1.86 or 10.00%.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Dexter-Almo Heights Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from these proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates shown in this notice.

The Dexter-Almo Heights Water District has available for inspection at its office the application which it submitted to the Public Service Commission. A person may examine this application at the Dexter-Almo Heights Water Office located at 351 Almo, Rd, Almo, KY 42020. You may contact the office at (270) 753-9101.

A person may also examine the application at the Public Service Commission's offices located at 211 Sower Boulevard, Frankfort, Kentucky, 40601, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., or through the Public Service Commission's website at <http://psc.kv.gov>. Comments regarding the application may be submitted to the Public Service Commission through its website or by mail to Public Service Commission, PO Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky, 40602. You may contact the Public Service Commission at 502-564-3940.

A person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, PO Box 615, Frankfort, KY, 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the application.
