<u>DUKE ENERGY KENTUCKY, INC.'S MOTION FOR DEVIATION FROM</u> FILING REQUIREMENTS

Comes now Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc., (Duke Energy Kentucky or the Company), pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001 Section 22, and moves the Commission for a deviation from the requirements governing the filing of paper copies of a Cost Allocation Manual in the context of its forthcoming Application for an adjustment of electric rates. In support of this Motion, Duke Energy Kentucky respectfully states as follows:

Duke Energy Kentucky filed a Notice of Intent to file an Application for an adjustment of its electric rates on August 2, 2017. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 16(7)(u), Duke Energy Kentucky is required to include a detailed description of the method used to allocate charges to the Company by an affiliate. Moreover, KRS 278.2205(6) requires that a Cost Allocation Manual satisfying the requirements of KRS 278.2203 and KRS 278.2205 must be tendered as part of the initial filing for an application for an adjustment in rates pursuant to KRS 278.190. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7(2) all filings must be submitted in a paper format.

- 2. Duke Energy Kentucky will be attaching a copy of its current Cost Allocation Manual to its Application, which will be filed on or about September 1, 2017. The Cost Allocation Manual alone is approximately 1,400 pages, however, and has previously been filed with the Commission in other contexts. Most recently, the Company provided the Commission with a copy of the Cost Allocation Manual on March 31, 2017, as part of its annual reporting to the Commission. Thus, complying with the Commission's Order to tender six paper copies of its Application in addition to the electronic copy, would require the filing of an additional 8,400 pages of paper which are believed to be in the Commission's possession already.
- Based upon the foregoing, Duke Energy Kentucky hereby respectfully requests permission, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22, to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001 Section 7(2) and to be allowed to file the Cost Allocation Manual in a PDF format on a CD attached to the Application. All other documents (approximately 20 volumes) will still be filed in paper format.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth herein, Duke Energy Kentucky respectfully moves the Commission to grant a deviation and allow Duke Energy Kentucky to file its Cost Allocation Manual in PDF format on a CD.
