



### NOTICE

On September 8, 2017, the City of Tompkinsville increased its rate for wholesale water service to Monroe County Water District. By order dated November 8, 2017 issued in Case No. 2017-00404, the Kentucky Public Service Commission approved an increase in the rates of Monroe County Water District to reflect Monroe County Water District's increased cost of purchased water. Customer rates will increase by \$0.94 per 1,000 gallons. This increase is effective for all usage on and after October 1, 2017.
