Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 2 in the Order dated April 4, 2018 in the above referenced case, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company are providing a status update on the PPL Corporation proposed corporate reorganization. PPL Electric Utilities Corporation (“PPL Electric”) filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“PUC”), requesting approval as required under the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code for a proposed corporate restructuring. As noted in the status update filed on May 2, 2019, the PUC issued an order on April 25, 2019 denying PPL Electric’s application. As noted in the status update filed on August 2, 2019, PPL Electric filed an appeal on May 24, 2019 with Commonwealth Court of Pennsylvania. As of this date, the PUC decision remains on appeal.
