# **Question No. 1**

Witness: Alexander J. Torok

- Q-1. Provide the projected future tax liability that could be avoided as a result of the proposed corporate restructuring.
- A-1. For the LG&E and KU Energy LLC (LKE) group of companies (including Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company) there will be no tax impact as a result of the proposed corporate restructuring.

PPL believes that in the event a distribution is taxable, it would be subject to the Pennsylvania state tax rate of 9.99%. PPL cannot predict the absolute amount of any such tax. The amount of the potential future tax liability is not estimable as it is dependent on the amount of a distribution in excess of the parent's basis in the stock of the distributing subsidiary and such distributions vary depending on the needs of the business.
