# Boone County election season is personal

A showdown for the job of Boone County's top elected official has spilled across social media this spring ahead of the May 22 primary election.

The winner of the two Republican candidates will face no opposition on the Nov. 6 General Election ballot.

Longtime Boone County Judge-executive Gary Moore's challenger is political newcomer Chris Reinersman.

Reinersman, a Union resident, is not related to independence Mayor Chris Reinersman.

Moore publicly ignored Reiners-

man's stream of Facebook attack videos and posts this spring until recently. Reinersman accused Moore's "political machines" of being behind the website [chrismeinersman.com](http://chrismeinersman.com). The website blames Reinersman for 2011 personal bankruptcy that led to county taxes not being paid.

Moore's campaign denied any involvement in the website detailing the bankruptcy.

No proof of Moore's involvement isn't stopping Reinersman from calling foul.

"A reasonable person can think he may be behind something," Reinersman said about Moore and the bankruptcy website.

Boone County's judge-executive for 19 years doesn't shy away from talking about Reinersman's personal bankruptcy. Creditors in the bankruptcy were owed \$572,000.

"The bankruptcy is relevant to this race," Moore said.

Acting as judge-executive means overseeing about \$100 million annually in Boone County, he said.

### Dragon boat training at AJ Jolly for international breast cancer survivors

Greater Cincinnati's premier breast cancer survivor (BCS) dragon boat racing team will be hosting over 80 BCS paddlers from Ohio, Florida, Pennsylvania, Washington, and Canada to participate in a two-day intensive on water dragon boat racing skills development clinic May 19th and 20th on A. J. Jolly Lake located at 1495 Race Track Road. The clinic will be conducted by "Hype" (Sue) Mastaglio, PhD. Hype, originally from Northern Kentucky, has been paddling and coaching dragon boats for nearly 10 years. She has competed at the World Championships as part of Team USA Premier since 2011 and most recently coached the Premier Women's team at the World Championships where they won the GOLD. She is also accomplished off the water. Hype holds a PhD in chemical physics. Being her home town, Hype says, "The Kentucky Thorough-Breeds enjoy a very special place in my heart. I am totally excited to be returning back to my roots for an incredible weekend of dragon boat racing clinics." Hype and the coaches from the other BCS teams will be focused on preparing the paddlers for the International Participatory Breast Cancer Survivor Dragon Boat Competition in Florence, Italy this July. This event is held at different locations around the world every four years. The Kentucky Thorough-Breeds will be representing the Greater Cincinnati Region as they compete against more than 120 other BCS teams from as many as 20 different countries. "It will be exciting to have the BCS teams together to prepare for the International Festival in Italy. For many of us, Italy will be our 1st race of the season so having a clinic like this to prepare the paddlers for the international event is crucial to all the teams success", said Kentucky Thorough-Breeds Co-Captain Colleen Minney. This clinic was nothing to the paddlers as the KTBs believe in supporting and giving back to these great athletes who share the diagnosis of breast cancer. The Kentucky Thorough-Breeds Dragon Boat Racing Team is committed to breast cancer awareness through participation in Dragon Boat Racing and attendance at public events until a cure is found. ### Ky. quota elk drawing results available May 15

How many people want to hunt the largest elk herd east of the Rocky Mountains? This year, on the 20th anniversary of Ky's elk restoration project, it was enough to pack both the KFC Yum! Center and Louisville Slugger Field to capacity. Kentucky received a record number of applications submitted by more than 35,000 people from as far away as Alaska and Hawaii. Now it is time to learn who has won the highly sought-after opportunity. The Commonwealth Office of Technology recently conducted an independent drawing to determine the winners and the type of permit to be issued. The Lexington-based accounting firm of Blue & Co. will assist in the validity of the results. The Ky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources received 79,768 applications this year for the 700 general and 10 youth quota elk hunting permits being offered. The names of those selected for the quota hunt will be first revealed at a special event set for soon (Eastern date), May 15, at the Mountain Arts Center in Pigeonburg.
