**JOINT MOTION OF**

**FOR LEAVE TO FILE REBUTTAL TESTIMONY**

Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company (collectively “Companies”) hereby move the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to grant the Companies leave to file rebuttal testimony in this case on Tuesday, April 24, 2018. As the applicants in this proceeding, the Companies bear the burden of proof, and therefore respectfully request the opportunity to rebut several of the claims made in the testimony submitted by Cathy Hinko, the witness for the Metropolitan Housing Coalition, and Kenneth Baker, the witness for Wal-Mart Stores East, LP and Sam’s East, Inc.


The Companies do not believe that allowing rebuttal testimony will prejudice the Commission’s investigation or the current procedural schedule. Rebuttal testimony typically narrows the issues in dispute, reduces the length of the hearing (if any), and provides the Commission a more complete and effective record. No hearing is currently scheduled in this proceeding, so no adjustment to a hearing date is necessary to accommodate the Companies’ request. Also, a deadline of April 24 for the Companies to file their rebuttal testimony will afford all parties adequate time to review the Companies’ rebuttal testimony and determine

whether to request an evidentiary hearing by the Commission's current April 26 deadline for filing such a request.

**WHEREFORE**, the Companies respectfully move the Commission for leave to file rebuttal testimony in the record of this case on April 24, 2018.

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
