Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) and Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) (collectively, the “Companies”), by counsel, respectfully petition the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 9(4) to schedule an informal conference at the Commission’s offices on a mutually convenient date and time for the parties and Commission Staff for the purpose of discussing their *Answers and Offers of Satisfaction* in this proceeding. In support of their motion, the Companies state as follows:

1. The Companies request an informal conference to discuss their *Answers and Offers of Satisfaction* to determine whether an efficient and expedient disposition of the *Complaint and Petition for the Establishment of a Regulatory Liability to Provide Consumers a Rate Reduction Because of Tax Expense Savings* filed by the Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. can be reached by the parties.

2. Counsel for the Companies will contact counsel for the Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, the Office of Rate Intervention for the Office of the Attorney General and Commission Staff this week to discuss a mutually convenient date and time to be proposed for the informal conference.

3. The Companies believe an informal conference can be the most efficient, and expedient process for resolving the questions raised in the Complaint,
