In accordance with KRS 350.055, notice is hereby given that Czar Coal Corporation, 81 Enterprise Drive, Debord, Kentucky 41214 has applied for a renewal of a permit for a coal processing facility affecting 786.15 acres located northeast of Odds in Martin County.

The facility is approximately 3.0 miles south from KY Route 3's junction with Middle Fork of Rockcastle Creek Road and located 0.1 mile west of the Middle Fork of Rockcastle.

approximately 204.02 acres located 0.2 miles east of Nolan, West Virginia in Pike and Martin Counties.

The permit area is approximately 2.1 miles southeast of SR-292's junction with Stepp Branch Road and located on Mount Sterling Branch.

The surety bonds now in effect are on: Increment 2 for \$28,900, Increment 7 for \$3,500, Increment 8 for \$7,800, Increment 9 for \$9,500, Increment 14 for \$5,500, Increment 15 for \$20,600, on Increment 18 for \$61,200 and on Increment 19 for \$31,600. Approximately 100% of the original bond amount is included in the application for release on Increments 18 and 19. Approximately 40% of the original bond amount is included in the application for release on Increment 2. Approximately 15% of the original bond amount is included in the application for release on Increments 7, 8, 9, 14 and 15.

Reclamation work performed includes backfilling, grading, seeding, fertilizing, and mulching that was completed in the spring of 2009 on increment 2, fall of 2010 on increment 8, spring of 2012 on Increment 9, fall of 2012 on Increments 7 and 14, and spring of 2013 on increment 15.
