ATTORNEY GENERAL’S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO SUBMIT COMMENTS

Comes now the intervenor, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Office of Rate Intervention (“Attorney General”), and hereby requests leave to submit comments in this matter. The Attorney General believes that by providing comments on the proposed Non-unanimous Stipulation and Settlement Agreement he can make his opinions known on the proposal while dispensing with the need to hold a hearing or submit a brief. The Attorney General’s proposed Comments are being provided as an attachment to the present motion.

The Attorney General proposes that Duke Energy Kentucky (“Duke”) and Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. (“KIUC”), be provided fourteen (14) days in which to file a response. After the filing of responses or the fourteen (14) day period having lapsed, the Attorney General proposes that the case be submitted on the record. Counsel for Duke and KIUC have represented that they do not object to the filing of this motion or the filing of comments, and they agree with the fourteen (14) day response period.

WHEREFORE, the Attorney General requests that the Commission grant him leave to submit his written comments in this matter, and grant Duke and KIUC fourteen (14) days in which to file responses, should they choose to do so.
