MOTION TO AMEND ORDER

On June 27, 2018, the Commission issued its Order in the above-referenced case authorizing Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) to issue securities and assume obligations as described in its application and extend the term of its existing revolving line of credit.

The last sentence of the first full paragraph on page 5 of the June 27, 2018 Order states: “KU estimates the amount of compensation to be paid to underwriters or agents for their services would not exceed one percent or approximately \$400,000.”

The \$400,000 does not include underwriting fees. In paragraph 30 of its application, KU stated: “Based upon past experience with similar financings, KU estimates that issuance costs, *excluding underwriting fees*, would be approximately \$400,000.”¹

THEREFORE, KU respectfully requests that the last sentence of the first full paragraph on page 5 of the Commission’s June 27, 2018 Order be amended to read as follows: “KU estimates the amount of compensation to be paid to underwriters or agents for their services

would not exceed one percent and KU estimates that issuance costs, excluding underwriting fees, would be approximately \$400,000.”
