MOTION TO RESCHEDULE THE EVIDENTIARY HEARING

Water Service Corporation of Kentucky (“WSCK”), by counsel, respectfully requests the Public Service Commission to reschedule the evidentiary hearing currently set for November 7, 2018. In support of its motion, WSCK states as follows:

WSCK operator John Turner passed away on Saturday, November 3, 2018. He was the supervisor of WSCK operations in Clinton, Kentucky, and had worked for the company since 2002. Visitation has been scheduled for the evening of November 6, 2018, and the funeral will be on November 7.

Several WSCK team members, including witnesses scheduled to appear at the hearing, plan to show their respect to the Turner family by attending the visitation, and some would attend the funeral. Those individuals had previously blocked November 6 as a day to travel to Frankfort, Kentucky, and prepare for the evidentiary hearing. Accordingly, in order to show respect for the Turner family and allow for adequate hearing preparation, WSCK respectfully requests a continuance of the evidentiary hearing set for November 7, 2018.


