
MOTION OF KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY
REGARDING ADOPTION OF DATA RESPONSES

Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) petitions the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to permit Caryl M. Pfeiffer, Director of Corporate Fuels and ByProducts, to adopt the testimony of Delbert Billiter, Manager of LG&E and KU Fuels, which was contained in KU's Responses to Information Requested in Appendix of Commission's Order dated August 10, 2018, Item Nos. 1-5, 8-11 and 18, which were filed on August 24, 2018.
