Provide a detailed explanation of what is meant by the "Control system" listed as the reason for an outage, beginning on December 27, 2018, of E.W. Brown Unit 7.
- A-1. The "Control system" is an ABB Advent Distributed Control System (DCS). In this event, the DCS programming did not respond quickly enough to system conditions. The programming was modified to react quicker, thus resolving the issue.
