ORDER

On January 30, 2019 Joe F. Childers, an attorney licensed to practice law in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, who is representing Intervenor Sierra Club, moved the Commission to admit *pro hac vice* Matthew E. Miller and Tony G. Childers & Associates, 300 Lexington Building, 201 West Short Street, Lexington, KY 40507, or another member of the Kentucky Bar Association, acts as co-counsel and is present at any and all proceedings before this Commission.
