- a. Provide the capital costs incurred by KU/LG&E as a result of restoration efforts due to the July 2018 Storm, as defined in the application.
 - b. Provide a list of the number of damaged poles by size.

A-2. **Original Response:**

- a. LG&E capital costs through September 30, 2018 related to the July 20th, 2018 storm are \$1,016,257 for Distribution and \$115,539 for Transmission. KU (KY only) capital costs through September 30, 2018 related to the July 20th, 2018 storm are \$4,494,427 for Distribution and \$314,703 for Transmission.
