- A-1. We have Master meters throughout our system that track the usage in that zone. We also have a telemetry that tracks flow, tank levels, pressures and usages in zones. Flush meters are installed throughout our system to record water flushed while keeping CL2 levels adequate. We use this information along with usage reports from billing software in our water loss spreadsheet.
 - a. We use an Excel spreadsheet that calculates water loss.
 - b. Attached is a copy of the Excel spreadsheet we currently use.
 - c. We modified a spreadsheet from information compiled from several water loss spreadsheets (DOW form, PSC form and other water districts).

I feel that if you have a way to quantify the amount of water that is lost, it should be included into other water used instead of water lost. The lost water is still accountable but no revenue is received the same as it would be with fire department usage or system flushing. A category could be created for line breaks, theft and tank overflows. If it were to get excessive, then corrective actions could be taken.
