- A-1. All customer meters are read on the first 2 working days of each month. Big Sandy Water has Neptune Radio Read Meters. After rechecks are completed and entered into the computer, a form is produced showing how much water was bought and sold in all zones. Also we have 16 zone meters that we try to read daily. Once an average is established and the readings start going up in a certain zone, then we know here to start looking for problems. All readings are calculated as soon as possible. We also have a Micro-Comm Telemetry that we use daily. We can check tank levels, flows and get pressure readings from the telemetry.
  - a. Big Sandy Water uses several different Excel Spreadsheets
  - b. All forms we use are included.
