Disaster aid stalls amid Puerto Rico squabble

Trump says US farmers, states should come first

WASHINGTON — Senate Democrats blocked a Republican disaster aid bill, saying more money is needed to help hurricane-torn Puerto Rico. But President Donald Trump opposes additional funding and says the U.S. territory is getting more disaster money than some states.

The move tossed long-sought relief for victims of hurricanes, floods and Western wildfires into limbo and escalated a fight between Democrats and Trump, who said Tuesday that he is the "best thing" that ever happened to Puerto Rico.

Trump claimed additional funding would come at the expense of U.S. farmers and states, and attacked the island's political leaders, alleging they "only take from USA." Puerto Rico's residents are U.S. citizens.

White House spokesman Hogan Gidley said it was "ridiculous" to question Trump's commitment to the people of Puerto Rico, but called the island "that country" in an interview with MSNBC. Gidley claimed the error was "a mistake."

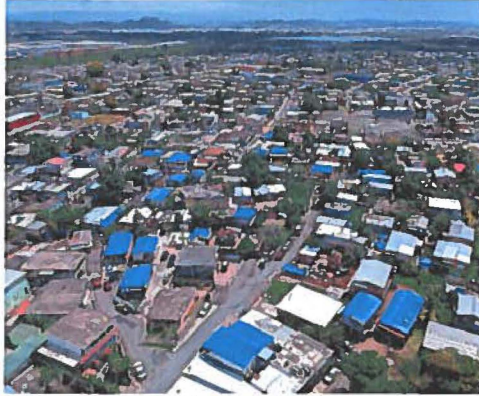
Monday's 44-49 vote fell short of a majority, much less the 60 votes required to overcome a Democratic filibuster, sending GOP leaders back to the drawing board and seeming unlikely to kill disaster aid efforts outright, since there is much political support to send aid to Southern farmers, wildfire-ravaged California towns and Midwestern flood victims.

"Our work on this subject is far from finished," Majority Leader Mitch McConnell, R-Ky., said.

Trump allies such as Sens. David Perdue, R-Ga., and Rick Scott, R-Fla., are among the strongest backers of the legislation.

"We will get this done eventually," Perdue said, promising relief to struggling farmers in his state.

The path forward is unclear, but a leading option is for the Senate to pass a more narrowly drawn bill simply to get

the issue into a House-Senate conference committee. House Democrats insist the talks must produce a final measure with help for Puerto Rico.

Democrats say Trump has been slow to release already appropriated funding for Puerto Rico and has shown little urgency in helping the island. Trump criticized the island's government at a meeting with Senate Republicans last week and suggested Puerto Rico has gotten too much disaster help compared with states such as Texas, using inflated numbers to make his case.

"Just as we leave no soldier behind on the battlefield, we help our fellow Americans when there's a disaster, wherever the disaster strikes. We do not abandon them. Period," said Minority Leader Chuck Schumer, D-N.Y.

Trump complained in a pair of tweets Tuesday about the island's leadership and said \$91 billion destined for Puerto Rico is "more money than has ever been gotten for a hurricane before, & all their local politicians do is complain & ask for

more money."

He said the politicians there are "grossly incompetent, spend the money foolishly or corruptly, & only take from USA."

"The best thing that ever happened to Puerto Rico is President Donald J. Trump," the president continued. "So many wonderful people, but with such bad island leadership and with so much money wasted. Cannot continue to hurt our Farmers and States with these massive payments, and so little appreciation!"

Puerto Rico Gov. Ricardo Rossello responded with his own tweets, stating in part, "Mr. President, this 'place' you refer to, #PuertoRico, is home to over three million proud Americans that are still recovering from the storm and in need of federal assistance. We are not your adversaries, we are your citizens."

Rossello also asked that all senators approve the disaster aid bill and disputed Trump's numbers, claiming that the Federal Emergency Management Agen-

cy has approved only \$300 million in permanent work projects, not \$91 billion.

The \$13.5 billion Senate measure mostly mirrors a \$14.2 billion measure the House passed in January, combining aid to Southern farmers, California communities devastated by last summer's wildfire, and hurricane-hit states such as Florida, Georgia and North Carolina. Hurricane-damaged military bases in Florida and North Carolina would receive rebuilding funds.

Democrats want to add almost \$700 million more to unlock further disaster aid for Puerto Rico and several states, including help to rebuild badly damaged water systems. Democrats are also trying to force the administration to release billions of dollars in rebuilding funds that have already been approved.

McConnell said the Senate measure is the fastest way to get aid to the South and the Midwest, along with nutrition aid to Puerto Rico, where food stamp benefits have already been cut.

"It is the only bill on the table with any provision for the Midwest flooding," McConnell said. "And it's the only bill on the table that could earn a presidential signature in time to deliver urgent relief on the nutrition assistance in Puerto Rico."

Political momentum for the measure — strongly backed by Trump's allies in Georgia, Florida and North Carolina, among other states — has only been heightened by massive flooding in Midwestern states such as Nebraska and Iowa, whose nominating caucuses are the first test for Democrats hoping to challenge Trump next year. The GOP measure would make Midwestern states eligible for more aid, and by blocking the bill, Democratic presidential contenders in the Senate are likely to face criticism.

Trump has yet to veto a spending bill despite some tough talk, and he has signed off on \$600 million to ease food stamp cuts in Puerto Rico.

Trump's \$91 billion estimate, said a White House spokesman, includes about \$50 billion in expected future disaster disbursements, along with \$41 million already approved. Actual aid to Puerto Rico has flowed slowly from federal coffers.

The alert said the teenager wears glasses, has a lazy eye and was last seen wearing a gray hoodie with black strings. She is described as white, 4-foot-8 and 130 pounds with brown hair and hazel eyes.

Her stepfather is described as white with gray hair and brown eyes and weighing 245 pounds.

The statement said Glenn Harper is believed to be driving a 2004 maroon Hyundai Sonata with a Kentucky tem-

porary license plate tag.

Specialty printing manufacturer expanding in Kentucky

HEBRON — A Kentucky manufacturer is expanding a plant in Boone County and adding 30 jobs. Armor USA, which creates specialty printing materials, plans to add 36 jobs with a \$3.3 million expansion project.

The expansion will add 32,000 square feet of office and storage space, increasing the facility's size to 13,000 square feet. Company leaders told state officials they expect to increase production by more than 60 percent between 2020 and 2030.

Armor manufactures thermal-transfer ribbons used for printing variable information onto labels and packaging. The company is a subsidiary of France-based ARMOR.

outside town, thought she was complying with the new rules. She has been on Medicaid for years and already had a job, working seven days most weeks as a home health aide. Her wages — \$9.25 an hour, with 50 cents more for hospice patients — and her hours met the new rules. Yet she received a June letter saying she needed to verify that her income made her eligible, or she would be cut off.

She called the listed phone number and faxed information to a state employee in Pine Bluff. She was told that, because she was exempt from the work requirements — in her case, because she was caring for her 20-year-old daughter recovering from a car accident and her 3-year-old granddaughter.

But on Aug. 18, she received another letter, saying she had been terminated because she had not verified her income. In December, four letters arrived saying she needed to update her email address, then 11 more in January. Each letter told her to create an online account. She doesn't have a computer and didn't realize that the program requires everyone to get an email address.

This winter, she applied to get her insurance back and is still waiting for an

answer. In all the 18 months, she hasn't seen a doctor for swelling in her right foot, which makes it hard to stand. Nor has she addressed the throbbing around the scar from her hysterectomy two years ago. "I won't go" to the doctor, she said, having just finally paid off, in \$10 monthly installments, a hospital bill for X-rays she needed for a torn tendon before she got onto Medicaid.

"I am just putting it in God's hands," Cloinger said. "He is going to let me stay on this Earth to see my granddaughter be raised." The kind of life on the edge that she speaks of is common here in Marianna, which has essentially been on a long slide ever since it grew up along the L'Angeuille River, a Mississippi tributary and regional shipping hub. This early spring, the river is swollen

from winter rains. The town's population, 4,115, is lower than a century ago.

Of Arkansas' 75 counties, Lev ranks 72nd in life quality, according to the national County Health Rankings project. Computers are so scarce that even the public library has a sign out front saying it does "not offer the Internet" — a special problem for those dealing with the work requirement, since they were not allowed to phone in their monthly reports in the first several months.

For now, what is clear is that some people on Arkansas Works are confused — because of both a lack of understanding about what rules apply to them and contradictory information from the state.

Last summer, a month before the first people were cut from Arkansas Works, Murdock, the legislator, and leaders from a historic

health clinic teamed up to plan a workshop about the new requirements.

They handed out fliers at barber shops and public-housing complexes, ran radio ads, and got a donation of 150 people, at least, they expected to show up. They set the time for the hour between when those with jobs got off work and when they went to church on Wednesday night.

Yet when the evening arrived, only one family showed up — and they came not so much to think they might get help finding work. Melissa Dubord, who helps people sign up for insurance and does community health work, thinks people didn't understand that the rules apply to them.

Murdock kept trying to spread the word at churches and barber shops. Dubord

got a kiosk put inside the clinic to help people do their monthly reporting in a county where 45 percent of homes have Internet access. Of the patients she offered to help, one man took her up on it.

In such a poor Delta town, she now believes, "to make job search a requirement, that is just wrong, because the jobs are not here."

Even her 31-year-old daughter, Conisha Gatewood, got caught in the confusion. Gatewood was a clinic patient until she was referred to an obstetrician-gynecologist for menopause-related bleeding caused by ovarian cysts. But when she arrived for a September checkup, she was told she no longer had insurance. "I was like, 'Yes, I do. They sent me the papers in June,'" she thought she had done everything right.

creating a password and an online account. The state had used an automated system to fill in her child-care job and work hours. A letter from the state confirmed that, she thought, telling her she did not need to search for a job because she already had one. But then another letter came, telling her she needed to do a job search after all.

"I was so confused," she said. "I already had a job. No one even told me what I needed to do."

By the time she was cut off, she had found a better-paying position, selling cellophane inside a Walmart. In January, she re-qualified to Arkansas Works — and was rejected because her December phone sales, high for the holidays, put her just over the income limit.

She has stopped filling prescriptions, including for the birth-control pills that
