Kevin Cornett from Buffalo Trace ADD discussed the process and benefits of having the system GPS mapped. To have the entire system mapped, including meters, valves, tanks, pump stations, etc. it will be approximately \$16,500 with an annual maintenance up to \$2,500. Danny made motion to start with valves, blow-offs, tanks, etc. Terry seconded. Motion carried.

Jr. Tilton and Chad Clark requested a \$250 monthly raise, increasing their monthly salary to \$1,750 each. After discussion, Randall made motion to grant a \$250 raise monthly for both Jr. and Chad, Danny seconded. Motion carried.
