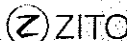

 ORDINANCE NO. 131-2019

AN ORDINANCE ENFORCING A REGULATORY LICENSE FEE ON THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Bardwell, Kentucky has authorized and estimated the expenses of the City for the last fiscal year and determined that the City has incurred additional costs as demonstrated by a significant increase in the regulation and administration of the sale of alcoholic beverages;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that imposing a five percent (5%) regulatory license fee on the sale of alcoholic beverages from the City, which is a regulatory license fee that does not exceed the total of the responsible expenses actually incurred by the City in the immediate previous fiscal year for the administrative costs, as determined by a reasonable assessment of policing, regulation, and administration;

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BARDWELL, KY:

SECTION 1 - Regulatory License Fee

In accordance with KRS 243.075, a regulatory license fee of five percent (5%) is hereby imposed on the gross receipts of the sale of alcohol beverages of each establishment located in the City of Bardwell and is to be applied to all alcoholic beverages.

SECTION 2 - Credit for Additional Licenses or Fee

The regulatory license fee shall be in addition to any other taxes, fees or licenses permitted by law, except that a credit against a regulatory license fee shall be allowed on a pro-rata basis to any licensee or fee imposed by the City.

SECTION 3 - Use of Revenue from Regulatory License Fees

This revenue received from the imposition of a regulatory license fee shall be used under subsections (1) and (2) of this section of this Ordinance:

- (1) To pay for the cost of the regulation and administration of the sale of alcoholic beverages;
- (2) To pay for the cost of the regulation and administration of the sale of alcoholic beverages.

SECTION 4 - Effective Date

In accordance with KRS 243.075(3), the regulatory license fee herein shall be in effect at the beginning of the current fiscal year and continues in full force until it is amended or revoked by a 2nd or 3rd order or other law or regulation.
