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C. It is further nutually agreed between the Seller and the Purchaser as follows:

- 2. (Delivery of Water) That 30 days prior to the estimated date of completion of construction of the Purchaser's water supply distribution system, the Purchaser will notify the Seller in writing the date for the initial delivery of water.
- 3. (Water for Testing) When requested by the Purchaser the Seller will make available to the contractor at the point of delivery, or other point reasonably close thereto, water sufficient for testing, flushing, and trench filling the system of the Purchaser during construction, irrespective of whether the metering equipment has been installed at that time, at a

flat charge of \$ 500.00 which will be paid by the contractor or, on his failure to pay, by the Purchaser.

- 4. (Failure to Deliver) That the Seller will, at all times, operate and maintain its system in an efficient monner and will take such action as may be necessary to furnish the Purchaser with quantities of water required by the Purchaser. Temporary or partial failures to deliver water shall be remedied with all possible dispatch. In the event of an extended shortings of water, or the supply of water available to the Seller in the size diminished over an introduct period of time, the supply of water to Purchaser's consumers shall be reduced or diminished in the same ratio or proportion as the supply to S. Ser's consumers is reduced or diminished.
- the Purchaser for water delivered are subject to modification at the end of every five (5) year period. Any increase or decrease in rates shall be based on a demonstrable increase or decrease in the costs of performance hereunder, but such costs shall not include increased capitalization of the Seller's system. Other provisions of this contract may be modified or altered by mutual agreement.

5. (Modification of Contract) That the provisions of this contract pertaining to the achedule of rates to be paid by

- 6. (Regulatory Agencies) That this contract is subject to such rules, regulations, or laws as may be applicable to similar agreements in this State and the Seller and Purchaser will collaborate in obtaining such permits, certificates, or the like, as may be required to comply therewith.
- 7. (Miscellaneous) That the construction of the water supply distribution system by the Purchaser is being financed by a loan made or insured by, and/or a grant from, the United States of America, acting through the Farmers Home Administration of the United States Department of Agriculture, and the provisions hereof pertaining to the undertakings of the Purchaser are conditioned upon the approval, in writing, of the State Director of the Farmers Home Administration.
- 8. (Successor to the Purchaser) That in the event of any occurence rendering the Purchaser incapable of performing under this contract, any successor of the Purchaser, whether the result of legal process, assignment, or otherwise, shall succeed to the rights of the Purchaser hereunder.
- 9. (Pledge) This contract is hereby pledged to the United States of America, active through the Promers Home Administration, as part of the security for a loan from the United States of America.

Dear Ms. Edwards,

Trimble County Water District No.1 has submitted a contract for the West Carroll Water Board to review at their next meeting for approval. Several years ago you and our District Board discussed the matter concerning the contract revisions.

I ask that you review a copy of the contract. You will notice that the Trimble County Water District has raised the amount of water that will be available from 500,000 to 2,000,000 gallons of water. The cost for each 1000 gallons will remain at \$1.74.

However, the District did add that every thousand gallons of water after 2,000,000 be at \$15.00 per thousand. This will help West Carroll in the future to request that the contracted amount of water available be raised when necessary. This will also help Trimble County Water District No.1 pay for any studies that must be done to evaluate if their system can handle supplying more than 2,000,000 gallons. Hopefully with this clause in the contract we will all review this more often.

We appreciate your patience with our District while we completed our comprehensive plan before we committed to 2,000,000 gallons of water.

Attached you will see the usage from 1999 to present that West Carroll Water District required from our District. We feel that you would have to have considerable growth or a tremendous leak before having to request additional supply from our District. There is approximately 500,000 gallons lead way before your District would need more than 2,000,000 gallons of water.

Trimble County Water District Commission wants to thank you for attending our meeting on June 7, 1999. As you are aware Trimble County Water District voted on May 12, 1999 to enforce a tap ban on new water services and line extensions not approved or prepaid before this May 12, 1999 to its existing water mains. The contract between West Carroll Water District and Trimble County Water District is for 500,000 gallons of water per month. Your system is currently using on average 1,500,000 gallons of water per month. At this meeting Ms. Edwards and Mr. Ballinger agreed to discuss in the future the rewriting of a contract between the two companies and comply with the tap ban enforcement until Trimble County Water District can correct Brays booster and pump station and increase the pumping capacity.

We appreciate your cooperation in this matter and will contact your company once the corrections have been made to our booster and pump station and the tap ban has been lifted.

As, requested here are my comments concerning the Trimble County/West Carroll Contract for Services:

- 1. Propose amending existing 60 year contract to bring it up to date rather than starting over with new contract.
- 2. Penalty for greater than 2,000,000 gallons is excessive.
- 3. Pressure of 30 psi should be increased to meet West Carroll's need to at least fill storage tank.
- 4. Meter test frequency should be at least annually
- 5. Add requirement that Seller will provide data needed for annual CCR with dates.
- 6. Add clause to allow for increase in water waters with notice given to purchaser at least XX days prior to allow purchaser to implement appropriate water rate adjustment.
- 7. Extend term of contract to year 2052 (fifty years).
