**WEST CARROLL WATER DISTRICT'S STATUS REPORT**

Comes now West Carroll Water District (“West Carroll”), by and through the undersigned counsel, and offers the following information for its April status report:

West Carroll and Carrollton Utilities continue to have discussions with key parties to discuss any potential loan forgiveness or grant money to monetarily assist in a merger or consolidation of West Carroll and Carrollton Utilities. West Carroll and Carrollton Utilities have also continued the merge discussions between their respective boards. However, the state of emergency for COVID-19 has slowed these discussions down. West Carroll expects the discussions to remain slow until such time as the state of emergency is lifted and procedures can return to something closer to normal.

West Carroll will continue to keep the Commission informed of the status of the merger negotiations and will file its next status report on or before May 1, 2020.
