


3. Due to Mr. Cooper's illness and the need to fill in for other district employees during this time the documents required by the Commission's November 22, 2019 Order have not been completed although good progress on them has been made.

4. Barring additional illness among employees, Cawood District believes that it can comply with the Commission's November 22, 2019 Order with a 40-day extension to and including November 2, 2020.

5. This motion is not made for the purposes of hindrance or delay but merely to allow Cawood District time sufficient to substantively comply with the Commission's orders.

WHEREFORE, Cawood District respectfully requests the Commission to enter an order allowing 40 additional days, to November 2, 2020, to comply with the Commission's November 22, 2019 Order.
