CAWOOD WATER DISTRICT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Comes Cawood Water District ("Cawood District"), by counsel, and moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") for entry of an order granting an extension of time to file reports, policies and other documents required by the Commission's November 22, 2019 Order, and subsequent orders which advanced the required deadline to September 22, 2020, due to the COVID-19 emergency. In support of this motion Cawood District states as follows:

1. Cawood District's General Manager, Grant Cooper, was internally tasked with the responsibility to prepare all the reports, policies and other documents contained in Appendix

B to the Commission's November 22, 2019 Order.

2. Mr. Cooper and at least three employees of Cawood District have been stricken with COVID-19 during the summer of 2020. Mr. Cooper was required to recuperate and quarantine from his illness and missed work from August 8 through September 8. The other three district employees missed substantial amounts of work in the past three months requiring Mr. Cooper to personally fill-in for them and perform their regular job duties. 3. Due to Mr. Cooper's illness and the need to fill in for other district employees during this time the documents required by the Commission's November 22, 2019 Order have not been completed although good progress on them has been made.

4. Barring additional illness among employees, Cawood District believes that it can comply with the Commission's November 22, 2019 Order with a 40-day extension to and including November 2, 2020.

5. This motion is not made for the purposes of hindrance or delay but merely to allow Cawood District time sufficient to substantively comply with the Commission's orders.

WHEREFORE, Cawood District respectfully requests the Commission to enter an order allowing 40 additional days, to November 2, 2020, to comply with the Commission's November 22, 2019 Order.
