## WEST CARROLL WATER DISTRICT'S STATUS REPORT

Comes now West Carroll Water District ("West Carroll"), by and through the undersigned counsel, pursuant to the Commission's March 13, 2020 and September 11, 2020 Orders and offers the following information for its status report due to be filed on November 1, 2020:

As the Commission has seen in the past few status reports, the current state of emergency for COVID-19 has slowed the merger/consolidation discussions between West Carroll and Carrollton Utilities. However, last month, West Carroll and Carrollton were able to have a telephone conference with Commission Dennis Keene of the Department for Local Government ("DLG") and staff of the Kentucky Infrastructure Authority ("KIA"). Carrollton Utilities has scheduled a strategic planning event for October 30, 2020 and the information gathered during the telephone conference with DLG and KIA will be a main topic of discussion. West Carroll should be able to provide more information after the October 30, 2020 strategic planning event is held with the December status report.
